Scarsdale Bone and Joint Specialists Celebrates First Year in Westchester

Dr. Barron is a well-recognized shoulder, elbow, and hand surgeon. An Attending Hand Surgeon at the CV Starr Hand Surgery Center at Roosevelt Hospital, Dr. Barron also is an Assistant Clinical Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons and a Senior Attending Physician in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery at St. Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital Center. With his colleagues Drs. Catalano and Zambetti, Dr. serves as a team physician at Fordham University. He also is the treating doctor for the New York Philharmonic Orchestra.

Dr. Catalano, a specialist in hand, wrist, elbow, and shoulder injuries and disorders, has been performing surgical operations at Lawrence Hospital for approximately four years. "I am impressed by the hospital's efficient operating room, highly skilled nurses, and comprehensive occupational therapy services," says Dr. Catalano. "Patients receive excellent care that helps them return to functionality as quickly as possible."
