Backal's restaurant at Heathcote Five Corners closed in early fall purportedly for renovations.

Sakura, a Japanese restaurant on Garth Road, closed and reopened under new ownership. Bella Fiore, closed at 37 Spencer Place and a new women's clothing store, Courage b, took its place. Pamela Robbins opened a new store on

Tru-fit shoes closed in October after 50 years at Heathcote Five Corners, originally as Buster Brown. Owners Leslie and Connie Vaccaro retired. Vintology Wine and Spirits opened in November at 10 Palmer Ave.

Westchester Choice Realty opened on Garth Road in August and All Antica pizzeria came to Depot Place in September.

Scarsdale Eyecare changed its name to the Eye Gallery of Scarsdale and Val Bella restaurant on Post Road changed its name to Tutta Bella Trattoria.

In October, 1 Christie Place West held an open house, showing off luxury condos priced from the high \$800s to more than \$2 million.

Snip-Its children's haircutting salon opened on Central Avenue in November. New York Sport and Spinal Therapy set up offices above CVS on Popham Road.
